1. REVIEW AND DISCUSS NUISANCE ABATEMENT PROCEDURES.

Judge Murphy opened the floor for discussion, allowing the commissioners, justices of the peace, and environmental enforcement to identify challenges in the current process, and begin working toward a solution that works for everyone involved. Judge Rasberry and Judge Richards agreed to work with Commissioner Robertson to develop a flow chart that will simplify the process for all parties and serve as a helpful tool for explaining it to residents with environmental concerns.

2. DISCUSSION ON BIOSOLIDS.

As Chair of the Biosolids Committee, Commissioner Robertson shared historical water sample data to help illustrate ongoing biosolids concerns in Polk County. However, more recent data from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is needed to provide a clearer and more complete understanding of the issue. The committee continues to seek members from diverse backgrounds—including medical, water, and agricultural/husbandry professionals—whose expertise is vital to effectively addressing this ongoing concern.

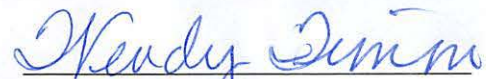
